

Hesham's Bio

Dr. Hesham El Deeb is currently the President of Electronic Research Institute as well as a member in the Specialist Presidential Committee for Education & Scientific Research. He held the position of the Supervisor of IT Infrastructure Sector at the Ministry of Communications & Information Technology. He began his career as a Supervisor of Egypt's Patent Office in the Ministry of State for Scientific Research and a Professor at the Electronic Research Institute. He then joined MCIT where he supervised and managed the teams responsible for executing over 100 national projects for the automation of governmental

organizations in a number of ministries, national strategic plans for communications and information technology, and preparation of plans and budgets required for implementations of IT Infrastructure projects for various ministries.

He has previously held numerous positions including the of Head of the GIS division at MCIT for two years, Professor at Systems & Computers department, Electronics research Institution, Ministry of Scientific research, Visiting Professor at Computers Department, Faculty of Engineering, California university, Irvine, USA, and Supervisor of Egypt's Patent office, Academy of Scientific Research & Technology.

Dr. Hesham obtained a Patent in Computer and Communications field from Egypt's Patent office in 2010. He also supervised over 10 Master & Ph.D. thesis in high performance computing & Information technology fields. In addition to his strong organizational, analytical and communication skills which is found to be crucial to the success of any project.

Moreover, Dr. Hesham participated in a number of scientific activities including heading and taking part in more than 20 of national & international research projects such as: US – Egypt Joint Fund projects, EU projects, national research projects. He is also author & co-author of three books in the fields of computers and information technology and took part in the preparation of the Intellectual Property Law in Egypt.
